#### TEV :: Process - Overall

- > Research and gather information about
  - project objectives
  - needs and requirements of the project/system
- Conduct a workshop to derive our approach
- Get priorities for each user group
- > Develop the project in iterative steps



### TEV :: Objectives

- Develop supporting infrastructure to enable teachers, parents, grandparents and students with research and planning tools to identify and maximize the educational value intrinsic to travel experiences
- Collect and Catalog top quality time-referenced and geo-referenced educational content from Texas State regions (i.e. Cities, Counties, COGS, MSAs)
- Help develop Age/Role appropriate content (for Students, Teachers, Parents, Grandparents)
- Implement Functionality to search educational experiences/attractions based on location (city, ZIP,county, MSA...); distance radius from destination and inter destination paths.



## TEV :: Objectives (continued)

- Develop Web enabled educational guides
- Implement Regional Mapping for seven key Texas regions (geographic terrain, weather, culture) & Interests/Rubrics (historical, architectural, urban, rural, sports, cultural, cuisines, etc.)
- Develop Age appropriate Interactive games (i.e. Treasure Hunt, Adventure Zone)
- Develop Web supported 'printable' materials
   (Brochures, Trip Guides, Teacher's Guides, Book Covers)
   in the form of repurpose-able content (e.g. print media)
- Support Multi-lingual content, mostly English and Spanish (as part of phase II)
